Connecticut REALTORS® Foundation Announces Grant Funds Availability

(CTRF) today announced the opening of its grant application for Connecticut-based organizations addressing opioid-related issues in Connecticut. Grants of up to \$50,000 each are available in four areas - prevention, treatment, recovery support and family support. Funds for the grants come from a variety of sources including proceeds from ticket sales to the public for "A Concert for Recovery" featuring Keith Urban, donations from major sponsors such as Ticketmaster and individual donations.

Connecticut REALTORS® (CTR) partnered with CTRF, iHeartMedia, WTNH and the Connecticut Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services to help end the stigma surrounding opioid use disorder - and to increase the awareness of services available in Connecticut.
